ROXBURY ROAD RACES CLUB SERIES CONTRIBUTES MONEY TO LIBRARY, LAND TRUST

ROXBURY – The Roxbury Road Races Club series has made contributions this month to the Roxbury Land Trust and the Minor Memorial Library in Roxbury. A committee, headed by Treasurer Janet Levy, awarded \$500 to the land trust. The series has now contributed more than \$2,300 to the land trust since holding its first benefit race at the River Road Preserve in 2009.

The check was presented to Ed Racz, a member of the land trust's Board of Directors, on Saturday, July 14, before the 3.0-mile race at the preserve. The committee also has given \$250 to the library to help sponsor its Summer Reading Finale Event - "Bring The Hoopla," a hula hoop class — on July 28. The road race series contributed money to the library during a July 2017 charity race and co-sponsored the Expand Your Mind summer reading kickoff celebration in June 2016 at the Everett Hurlbert Community Park at 18 Apple Lane.

The series holds 38 races each year, a marathon and a half marathon, as well as a Thanksgiving Charity race.
