Andrejczyk, Miller Pace Respective Fields Over Roxbury Hills

ROXBURY – Running along some steep up-hill and down-hill stretches, Mark Andrejczyk and Elizabeth Miller annexed the championship derbies over 5.0-mile loop at the weekly Roxbury Road Runners Club series.

Andrejczyk was clocked in 35-minutes, 49-seconds –a 7:10-per-mile pace – on the route Saturday, June 26, which included a trip up the long hill on Apple Lane and down the hill on Squire Road.

Miller of New Fairfield took 14th place overall and first in the women’s division with a time of 41:04.
