Clarke, Danay Prevail On The River Trail

BROOKFIELD – Brady Clarke and Kateri Danay were the individual champions over a challenging course that included a mile of trails, rocks, stones and mud near the Shepaug River.

Clarke was first overall in the Roxbury Road Runners Club event with a time of 27-minutes, 52-seconds – a 7:58 per mile pace - over the 3.1-mile loop.

Danay placed fifth overall and first in the female division in the Saturday, October 9, run with a 32:15 clocking.

The series will resume on Saturday, October 16, at 8:30 a.m. with a 3.1-mile race that will go down and then up the hill on Hemlock Road.

Runners can enter through the \$25 season membership. They also can compete by completing the weekly waiver form. If they have a timing chip the cost is \$2. If they do not have a chip the fee is \$5. Youth runners can participate for free after completing the weekly waiver.

All runners should pre-register through the link at www.roxburyraces.net.

The runners will be collecting non-perishable food donations at each race from Saturday, November 6, through the end of the season on Saturday, December 11, for the Roxbury Food Pantry.

The Roxbury Thanksgiving Day Charity Race will be run on Thursday, November 25, at 9 a.m.

The races, which are sanctioned by the Roxbury Recreation Commission, start and finish near the Everett B. Hurlburt Community Park.
